

“City of Portage” Toter Placement Policy

Please observe the following Policy to avoid interruption in service or being tagged with a notice.

- Main rule to observe, KEEP ALL objects three (3) feet from the toter;
- Before 6:00am on your trash day, the toter is to be placed at the curb;
- Do not place toter at the curb in a backwards or in a sideways position;
- Do not place toter near mailboxes, lamp posts, and telephone poles;
- Do not place toter under low hanging tree branches or power lines;
- Do not place trash bags or other objects on top of the toter;
- Do not place or lean any object against the toter;
- Do not place toter next to another toter;
- Do not place toter near parked vehicles;
- Avoid placing toter in the easement/sidewalk areas, very difficult for arm trucks to retrieve;

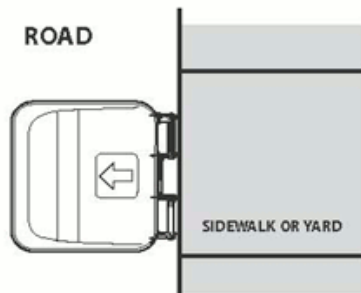


Below are some diagrams and a picture for an example of proper toter placement.
